Area is the part of the country your property is in.

Assistant is your main contact person, usually a Housing Officer.

Statement Date is the date the statement was printed off, therefore it will only show payments made and received up to this date.

Personal Details these are the details of who is the registered tenant with the property address.

Tenant Number is your personal reference number.

Rent Details show a breakdown of what you actually pay for.

Rent is the charge for your home. It takes into account whether it is a house or a flat and how many bedrooms it has.

Service Charge is the charge that covers the costs of keeping estates, facilities and services provided in good order, to which everyone contributes. On the rent statement these are all listed under rent details. Some may be blank on your statement as not every home requires a service charge, and service charges can differ.

Period No is the week number based on the week in the financial year that runs from 1st April to 31st March

Transaction Date is the date payment was made or received.

Rent Due is the total charge due for your property

Payment Received shows personal payments you have made, Housing Benefit payments and supporting people payments

Arrears (AR) money that is owed on your rent account.
