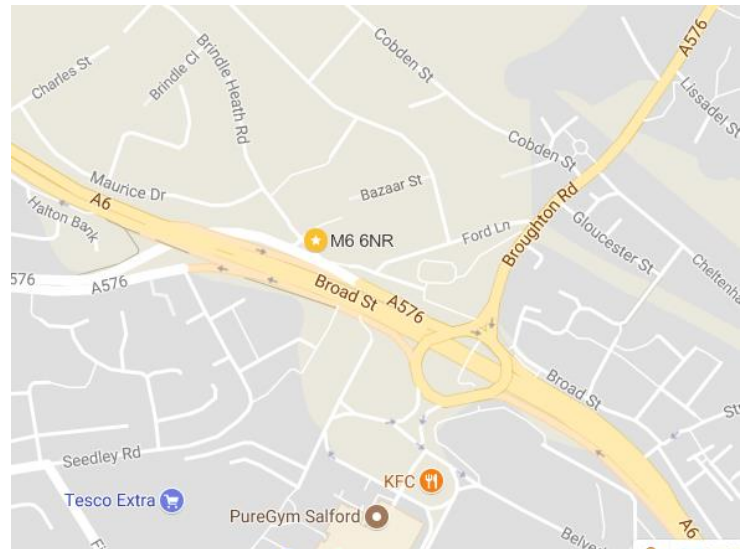
## Abbott Lodge

## At Abbott Lodge

Welcome to Abbott Lodge.

We offer 10 resettlement flats and 10 assessment rooms. Abbott Lodge was completed in Dec 2011 and was designed to support individuals experiencing homelessness.

Residents are licensed to an en-suite room and given access to a shared kitchen. There are lovely gardens to the rear of the property and activity rooms with outside decking area.

Residents will be allocated a keyworker at the commencement of their stay.

Accommodation is only offered for a period of 6-8 weeks and so residents and their keyworker with support from Salford Housing Options workers work quickly in order to secure longer term accommodation.

All referrals to Abbott Lodge are initially assessed by SHOP. SHOP also work closely with staff and residents to secure more permanent accommodation for those living at Abbott Lodge.
